2D Zooming	Zoom to full view	Ctrl-0 (zero; Win) or Command-0 (zero; Mac)	The entire extent of Switzerland (or respectively, Europe) will be displayed in the map window.
2D/3D Zooming	Enlarge	Ctrl (Win) or Command (Mac)	Infinitely variable zooming in: makes a rectangular section in the map; you can zoom in directly by pressing Ctrl (Win) or Command (Mac).
	Reduce	Alt and Ctrl (Win) or Select and Command (Mac)	2-fold zooming out: click on the map; you can zoom out directly by simultaneously pressing Alt and Ctrl (Win) or select and Command (Mac).
2D Comparison	Top ten	Ctrl-t (Win) or Command-t (Mac)	Inserts the ten greatest/highest values of the map topic.
	Flop ten	Ctrl-f (Win) or Command-f (Mac)	Inserts the ten smallest/lowest values of the map topic.
	Delete	Backspace or delete	One or more selected values can be deleted. If no value has been selected, all entries are deleted.
2D/3D Bottom bar	Back	Ctrl-z (Win) or Command-z (Mac)	Go back to the previous map in the history.
	Forward	Ctrl-Shift-z (Win) or Command-Shift-z (Mac)	Advance to the next map in the history.
	Print map	Ctrl-p (Win) or Command-p (Mac)	Prints the 2D/3D map section with the title and scale.
	Save map settings	Ctrl-s (Win) or Command-s (Mac)	Saves the current version of the 2D map or 3D map (MyMap) on the hard disk.
	Load saved map	Ctrl-o (Win) or Command-o (Mac)	Loads your own 2D map or 3D map (MyMap) from the hard disk.
	Quit Atlas	Ctrl-q (Win) or Command-q (Mac)	Exit the atlas.
3D	Draw 3D map	Ctrl-d (Win) or Command-d (Mac)	The 3D map visible in the preview window is drawn in the map window.
	Abort drawing 3D map	esc	Picture construction can be stopped at any time using Esc.
3D Block-diagram	Zoom to full view	Ctrl-0 (zero; Win) or Command-0 (zero; Mac)	The entire extent of Switzerland (or respectively, Europe) will be displayed in the map window.
